CAPE BRETON BIBLE CAMP UPDATE

It's hard to believe the last time we reached out the camp season hadn't begun, and now we have finished the last week. It has been a good but challenging summer at camp. We ran at almost full capacity for the 6 weeks of camp - our capacity was 60 and we had 48-55 campers almost every week, which are the highest numbers we've seen in the last 6 years. There were over 300 kids in attendance. We don't have a current total of how many kids received salvation, but we know there were at least 2 each week, and more counselled for assurance. We closed our Wilderness Skills camp two days early due to norovirus but were able to reopen for the final week of camp.

Dining Hall Renovations: We are still looking to repair the rotting bottom courses of log on the dining hall. The estimated cost of this project is about \$30,000. Please consider contributing to this project also.
